Important Information

Reservations are required to attend Family Camp. A parent or guardian MUST accompany any children that plan to attend. Please call 970-596-0505 by June 11th to let us how many in your family will be attending.

DIRECTIONS: From Montrose take Highway 90 west (starting at the intersection of Townsend Avenue and Main Street also known as intersection of State Highway 550 and 90) go to County Road 6250 which takes you to Dave Wood Road. Camp is approximately 15 miles from downtown Montrose. Just as you get to the tall ponderosa pine trees turn left at the camp sign on Bible Camp Road. If you reach the Uncompahgre National Forest, you went too far.

COST: Offering will be taken at Saturday service to help cover food costs.

CHECK-IN: Friday, June 18th, 2021 from 12pm-2pm **CHECK-OUT:** Saturday, June 19th at 7pm, 2021

WHAT TO BRING: There will be two dorms for the ladies and two dorms for the men. A warm sleeping bag or appropriate bedding, a pillow if you wish, warm coat for cool evenings, shoes for hiking, water bottle, and modest shorts and T-shirts are to be worn for the water slide and game time. Also bring a Bible, pen, notebook, flashlight, and personal belongings such as toothbrush, soap, towels, shampoo, etc.

There are fourteen RV power and water hook ups and there are five full RV hook ups (first come first served).

There are many tent sights to choose from.

The chapel will sit 300 so we have plenty of room for social distancing, if you feel the need. Meals can be served in such a way to accommodate spacing as well, if desired. We have ample soap, sanitizer, and disinfectant. The camp has been meticulously cleaned and sanitized to ensure a safe and healthy environment.
